

Day 1 - 28/12 : Arrival in Casablanca.

Upon arrival in Casablanca, the economic capital of Morocco, you will be met by our guide . Depending on arrival time, you will visit the city, of Casablanca "the white city" begins with an orientation tour through its broad avenues, stroll through the United Nations Square, the Place Mohammed V, the residential district of Anfa, Boulevard of the Corniche along pools and restaurants and then we visit the Hassan II Mosque the second largest mosque in the world it is one of the rare mosques opened to non-Muslims.

Overnight at Hotel Casa Diamond.

Day 2 - 29/12 : Casablanca – Rabat – Tangier.

In the morning after breakfast, leave for Rabat, the capital of the kingdom to visit the fortified Oudaya Kasbah, Hassan Tower where 4 facades are decorated

differently from each other, the old mosque and the Mohamed 5 Mausoleum next to the tower.

Then after lunch we make our way directly to Tangier, renowned as the northern Moroccan Bride. Check in to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Overnight Le Grand Mogador Tanger.

Day 3 - 30/12 : Tangier - Chefchaouen

After breakfast, you will have the full day to spend in Tangier, where you can explore its narrow, winding streets, vibrant souks, and historic sites like the Grand Socco and the Petit Socco. The tour often includes a stop at the Kasbah Museum, offering insights into Tangier's history and culture, followed by a visit to the American Legation Museum, a symbol of the long-standing US-Moroccan relations.

Next, you'll head to the scenic Cape Spartel for panoramic views of where the Atlantic Ocean meets the Mediterranean Sea, and then visit the mythical Caves of Hercules.

Then leave for Chefchaouen. On the way we will stop at Aksour to marvel at the nature sceneries and you can take plenty of pictures.

After that we continue to Chefchaouen for dinner and overnight for the end of the day.

Overnight at Dar Echchaouen

Day 4- 31/12 : Chefchaouen - Fes

On the third day and after breakfast you will have the time to explore the blue pearl of Morocco Chefchaouen, famous for its blue washed houses and soothing atmosphere, after finishing your visit we will head to the next destination which is Fes, one of the imperial cities. The drive will be a soothing travel through the Rif Mountains.

After lunch we will have a direct transfer to Fez, to the cultural and spiritual capital of Morocco. Check into your hotel for the overnight & dinner.

Overnight at Les Merinides Fes

Day 5 - 01/01 : Fes Medina Guided tour.

After breakfast in the hotel, you'll start exploring the cultural capital of Morocco. The day will start with an oriental tour in a car.

The tour will include Borj North and South to see panoramic views of the whole medina of Fes, the Royal Palace, the famed Jewish quarter of the medina, ceramic factory and Bab Boujloud. You will start the guided walking tour through the narrow streets of the medina, one of the largest cities in the world. We will have a lunch break in Medina then we continue the rest of the tour and fascinating monuments.

You will also visit the Quaraouiyine Mosque founded in 859 by Fatima el Fihri and the Andalusian Mosque, the Nejjarine Fountain, Medersas founded in the 13th century, Chouara Tanneries and Souk Attarine. Overnight & dinner stay in a hotel.

Overnight at Les Merinides Fes

Day 6 - 02/01 : Fes - Merzouga:

Depart early from Fez to begin your ascent. We go across the Middle Atlas Mountains, pass through Ifrane, a winter ski resort established by the French in the 1930s to imitate a Swiss hamlet, and reach the cedar forest in Azrou where you may see monkeys.

As you traverse the Atlas Mountains and start to descend toward the Sahara Desert, you will spend the majority of the day threading your way through picturesque forests, springs, angular rock walls, and Berber settlements.

Halfway, you will stop for lunch in Midelt, which is well-known for its fossils and rocks, and then we will continue towards Merzouga on the road, where we will halt in a panoramic view to observe a big oasis of palm trees.

We will arrive in Merzouga in the afternoon and get ready for the camel ride at the sandy dunes or Erg Chebbi. You will enjoy the beauty of the sunset while camel riding. Overnight and Dinner.

Overnight at Bivouac Deluxe Merzouga.

Day 7 - 03/01 : Merzouga - Dades

After breakfast, you'll take a trip to Dades over the rocky Road of a Thousand Kasbahs, which rise up like turreted sand castles along this ancient caravan trading route.

The middle part of Morocco is one of the most thrilling and romantic places to visit. It is surrounded by lush river valleys, palmeries, and burnished mud-brick buildings that are alive with bright color beneath a clear desert sky.

We continue with a stop of lunch before proceeding to Tinghir, we'll pass by spectacular escarpments and deep gorges as we make our way through the Ziz Valley. After a walk through the Gorge of Todra, we'll pause to have lunch there before continuing on to Dades for the overnight and dinner for the end of the day.

Overnight at Xaluca Dades

Day 8 - 04/01 : Dades - Ouarzazate - Marrakech

After breakfast, we will travel to Ouarzazate to explore the The Ouarzazate Cinema Museum, which was started as a filming facility in 1981 by Italian film companies. The museum is located next to the city's artisanal complex.

It covers 2 hectares and has several sets of films linked to the history of the Bible and that of the great films shot in the region.

The museum was designed to be a site to preserve cinematographic memory, to increase tourism in the city, and a venue for cultural and artistic activities. We also stop at Kasbah Ait ben Haddou. We will arrive in time for lunch.

Here we can visit the famous Kasbah, declared UNESCO World Heritage and which was the scene of films like The Gladiator, Babel, Lawrence of Arabia...

Then we continue passing through the High Atlas and the Tizi-n-Tichka pass, a road that ascends from the plains to a pass that is 2,260 meters above sea level.

Eventually, Upon arrival at Marrakech, one of Morocco's most enchanting medinas. Dinner and sleeping arrangements in a hotel or riad.

Overnight at Hotel Kenzi Menara Marrakech

Day 9 - 05 /01 : Marrakech Guided visit - Casablanca

In the morning, you will start a private walking tour to explore the main attractions and monuments of Marrakech, the "Red City."

Our guide will show you around one of the main monuments that are a must-see.

During your visit you will have more of an insight of historical background on these following monuments : Koutoubia Minaret, the Bahia Palace...

After lunch we will begin with the historical and cultural sites in the medina of Marrakech including Berber arts and artisans, museums and colorful souks as well as the interesting square of Jemaa El Fna.

Then leave for Casablanca For the end of the day.
